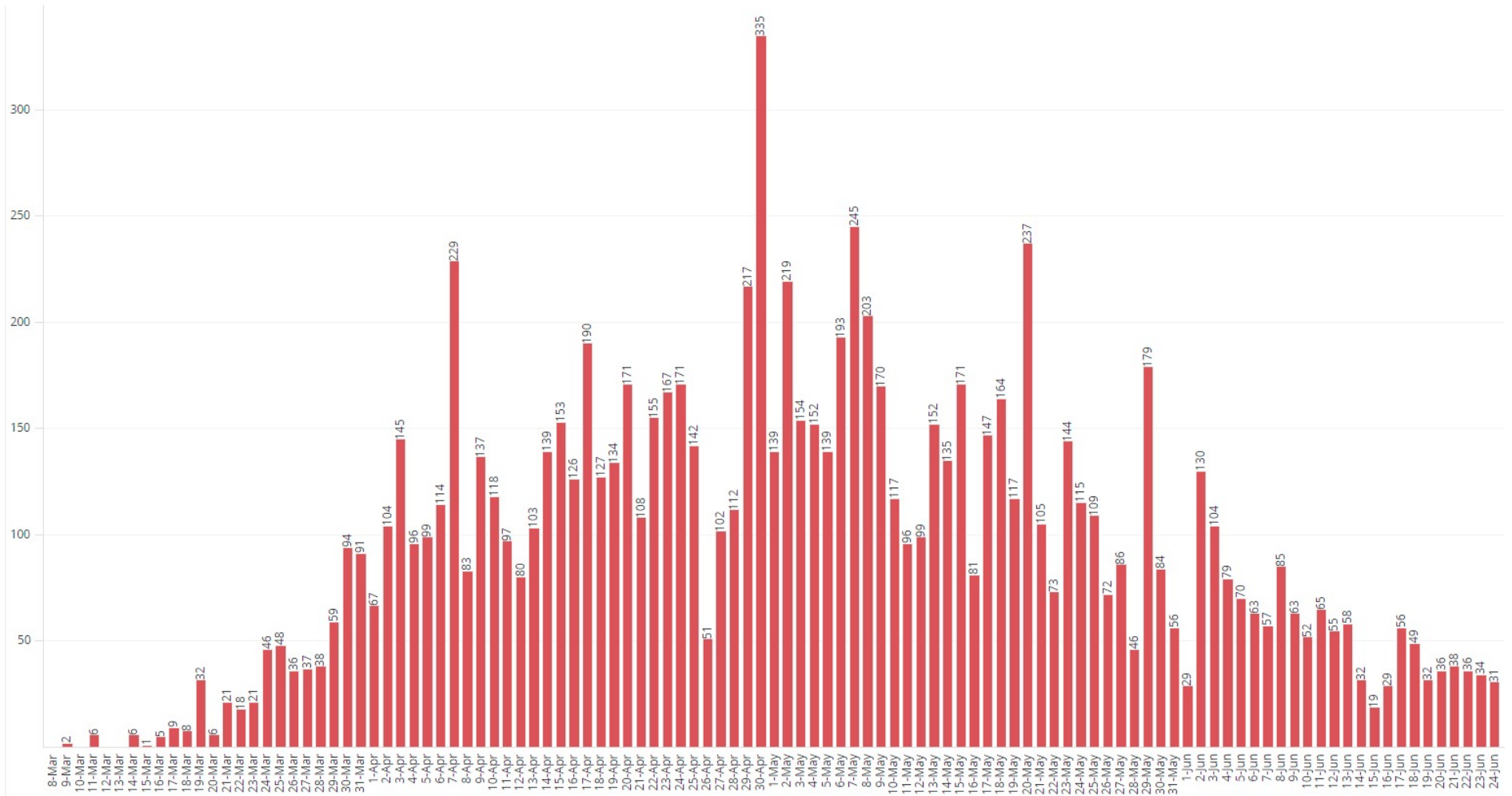

Large outdoor gatherings are still **high risk,** especially when people are close together and unable to properly **social distance.**

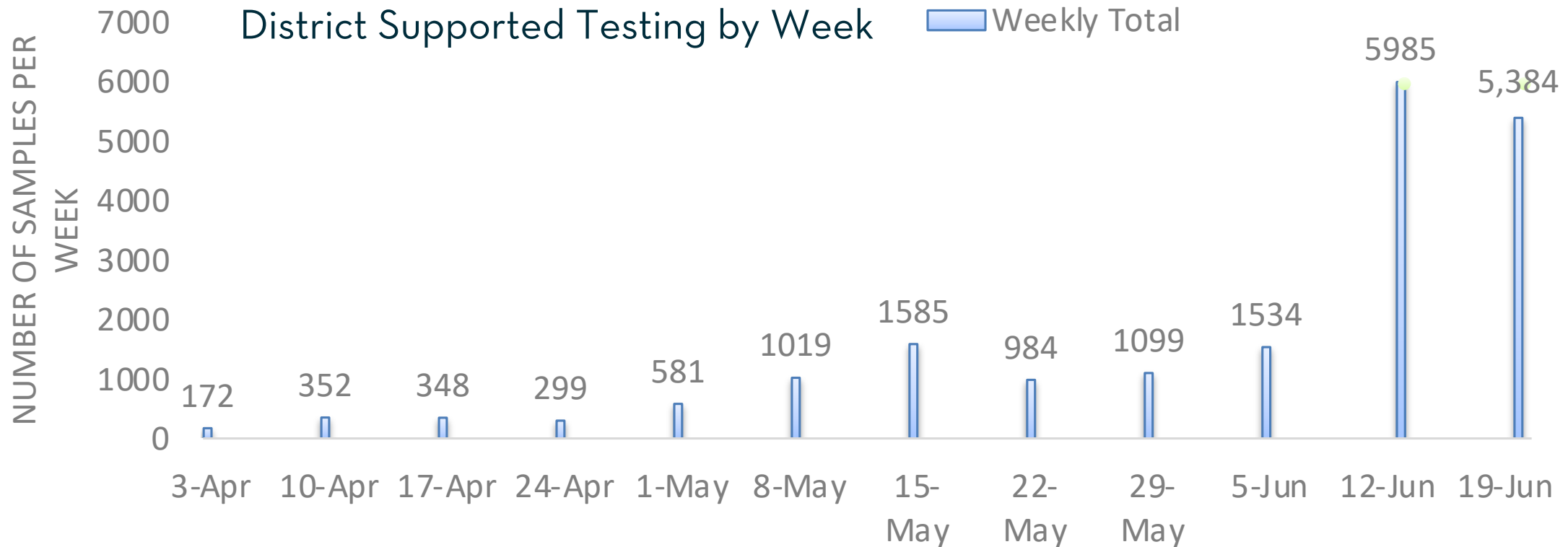
# New Cases by Day

the virus.

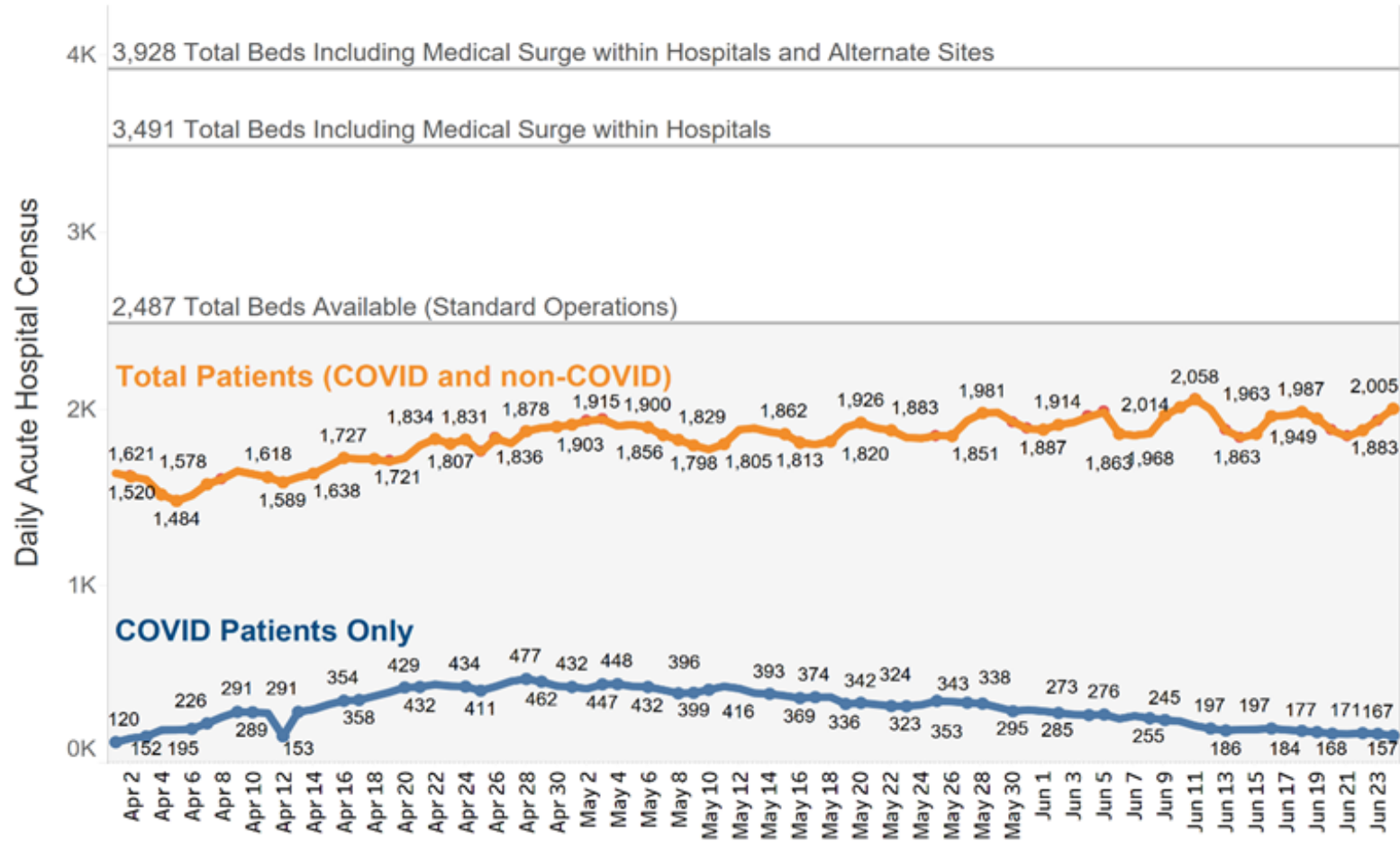

**Washingtonians continue to be hospitalized with COVID-19.**

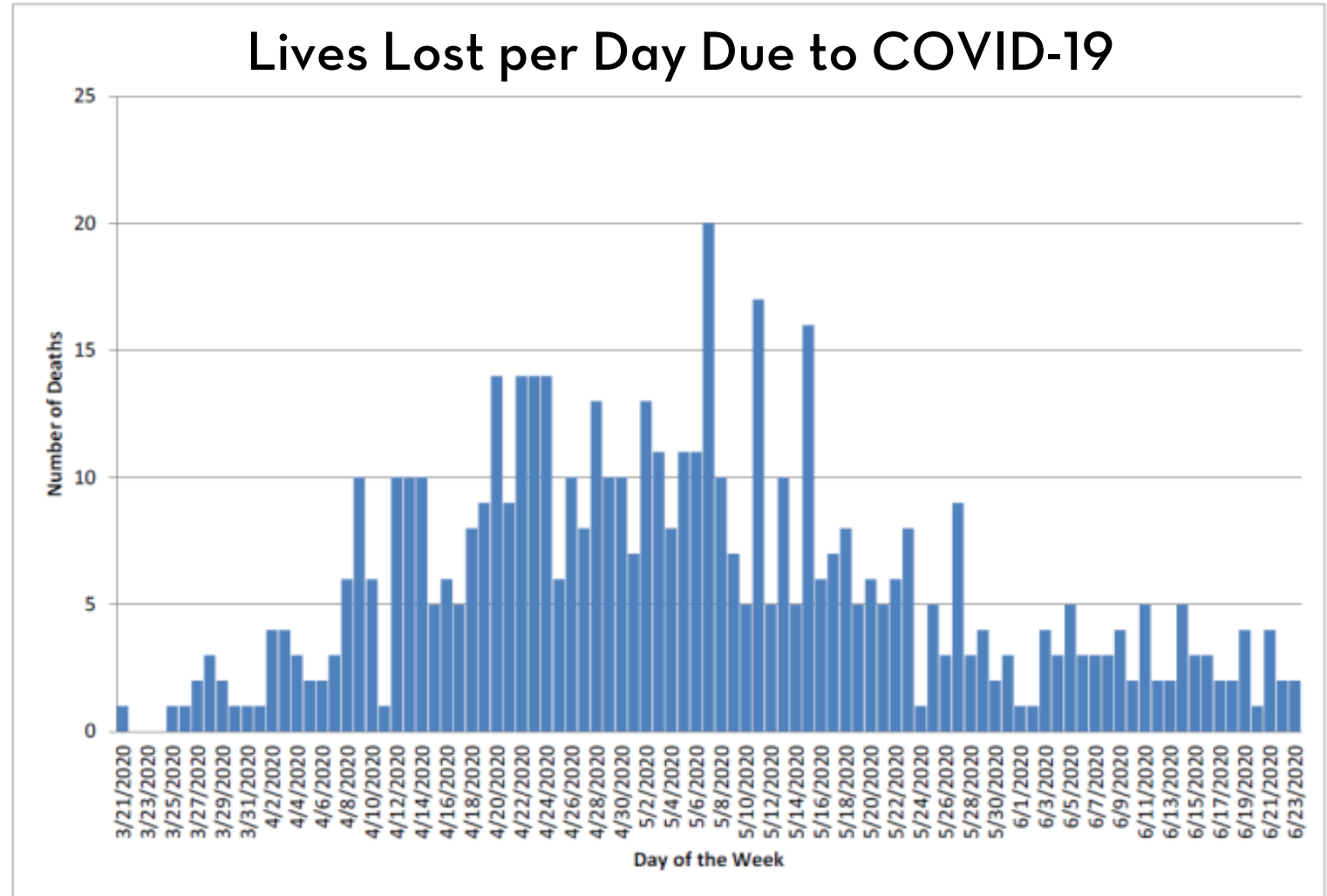




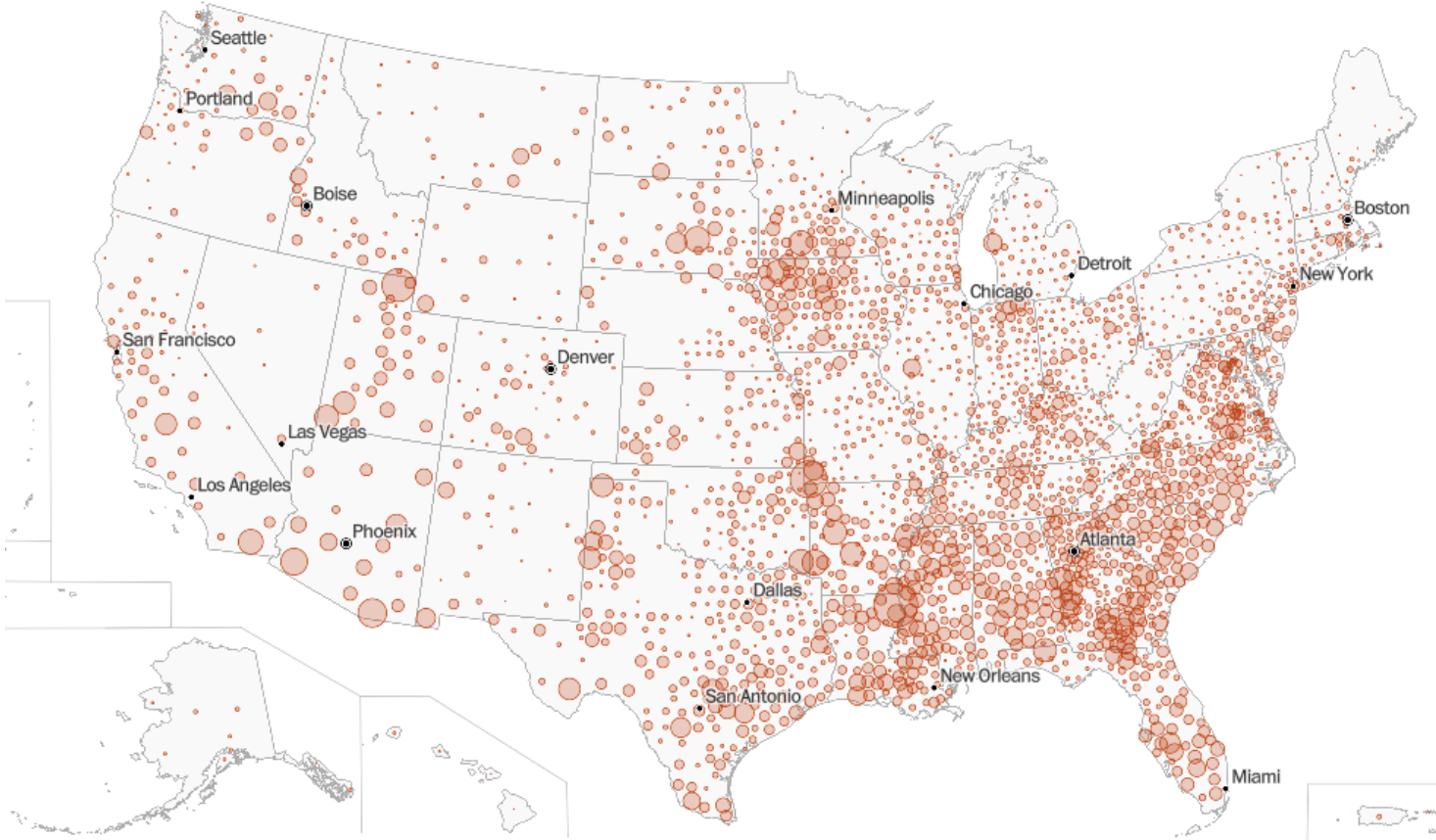
**We have lost 541 neighbors to the virus.**
